### BASIC RULES OF CONDUCT ON THE WATER

1. Fishing is permitted only with an appropriate fishing license.
2. Fishing is permitted only with an appropriate fishing tackle..
3. Fishing is permitted only with three rods + one float rod or lure rod.
4. All uninjured fish belonging to protected species must be returned to the water, as well as certain species caught during closed seasons.
5. Motorboats with more than 5 horsepower are prohibited.
6. Please, respect nature. Don't throw your trash into water, but dispose it in proper receptacles.
7. Please, respect nature. Don't break equipment, don't write on the walls of facilities. You will come again, and so will somebody else after you have gone...
8. Please, respect nature. Don't make noise or any loud sounds, but enjoy the soft whispering of the water.
9. The fish that died from unintentional harm or injury is not allowed to be thrown into the water. Dead fish should be handed in to the appropriate personnel.
10. It is strictly forbidden to cross to the other bank (i.e.to the territory of Republic of Srpska), or to land across the lake . You won't have any

problems as long as you keep your boat at least 50 m away from the bank of Republic of Srpska.

11. Upon arrival you will be issued a life jacket in your size, which must be worn on the water and be returned upon departure.

## **GENERAL SPORT FISHING REGULATIONS**

1. Fishing lasts 24 hours.
2. A maximum of four rods per angler is allowed (three rods in water and one float rod for white fish or one lure rod)
3. Fishing platform with an ethno log cabin is designed for accommodation and stay of two adult persons (children aged 10-15 are allowed, but must be accompanied by a parent)
4. At the distance of 50-70 m in front of each platform there are metal buoys with solar powered light (the distance between each one of them is 70 m) which mark a fishing zone and a spot where carps are supplementary fed on regular basis.
5. Only one fishing marker per angler is allowed, but must be placed in a fishing zone, that is to say, between two fixed buoys.
6. It is deep fishing, and only one hook per rod is allowed. Float fishing is allowed provided it doesn't disturb fishing activities in other fishing zones around your platform.
7. It is obligatory to use rod pods, that is to say, rod pods with bait indicators.
8. Fishing line must not be thinner than 0.25 mm .
9. Only safety carp fishing systems are allowed. Use of fixed fishing gear is prohibited. Use of lead sinkers weighing less than 50 grams is not allowed.
10. Only the following carp fishing baits and supplementary fish food are allowed: boilies, soft boilies, all types and shapes of particle baits, and pellets not exceeding 22 mm in diameter. It is only allowed to mount bait on a fishing hair.
11. For predator fishing (fishes such as: pike, catfish, zander....) livebait, such as bleak of appropriate size, is allowed, except for river crabs.
12. Remote control fishing tackle, such as remote control bait boat, is allowed.
13. Use of fishing sonars is allowed only with a special permission from the management.

14. Use of PVA strings, PVA tapes, PVA webs and PVA bags is allowed.
15. It is obligatory to use measure nets with meshes not exceeding 10 x 10 mm, as well as a minimum of two fishing sacks, one unhooking mat, and one digital scale with tape measure per team, that is to say , per two anglers ( all of it can be rented , too).
16. The fish are fed exclusively during day from 07 AM to 07 PM.
17. When laying fish on the unhook mats make sure that they are wet. The same goes for the carp sacks where fish will be placed and kept until they are photographed and measured. Each fish must be treated with utmost care and be returned to the water unharmed.
18. Neither setting fire nor use of gas bottles and gas lamps is allowed during the night.

### **BAG AND POSSESSION LIMITS**

\* Total length of a fish is measured in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the center of caudal fin.

\* Each fish caught during the closed season or below the minimum size limit must be returned unharmed and without taking it out to the dry ground.

Weekly bag limits for the highest quality fish are as follows:

- Wels catfish – one fish weighing from 10 to 20 kg
- Pike – one fish weighing from 3 to 8 kg
- Zander - one fish weighing from 2 to 6 kg
- Common carp - one fish weighing from 4 to 10 kg
- Huchen, tench and brown trout - no possession allowed

All fish below above mentioned size limits must be returned into the water.

Seven day guests are allowed to take 10 kg of white fish, which will also be prepared, frozen and packaged.

### **OUR OBLIGATIONS**

- Transportation from the airport to the lake and back.
- We provide a motor boat with 5 HP and the full fuel tank, two oars and a life jacket.
- We provide three meals a day (breakfast, lunch and dinner) which are delivered from the centre to each stilt log cabin packed in catering packs .
- We provide initial contents of mini bar.
- Coffee and more than 20 kinds of tea – free of charge.
- 20 kg of cooked corn per team (per two anglers).
- We provide fishing tackle rental service (rod pods with bait indicators, carp sacks, unhook mats, measure nets, etc.)
- We provide fishing licenses.

Fishing week starts on Saturday afternoon (first service dinner) and ends on the following Saturday (last service lunch).

### **YOUR OBLIGATIONS**

- You must strictly abide by the above rules and regulations.

- You must wear a life jacket at all time when on boat.
- You must inform our staff about every trophy catch and keep it until it is photographed.
- You must inform our staff in advance of the services you would like to use.
- You must keep the boat clean and maintain the surrounding area, leaving it clean just like you found it.
- You must use an unhook mat and a carp sack and handle fish carefully.
- If you need additional food, drink, cigarettes or any other commodity, please, make a signed list and give it to your food deliverer. These services will be charged on the last day of your stay in administration building.
- You are only allowed to use the boat you are provided with, and not any other. Boats with more than 5 HP are reserved only for our staff.
- You should check the engine condition, when you receive the boat. If you see any damage to it, don't accept it. The moment you take the boat you are responsible for its condition.
- You must slow down in the shallow water or where there are underwater trees and stumps, and you should try not to wear down the engine.
- If you hear any strange sounds coming from the engine or have any other problems with it, you must inform the staff immediately.
- Drive slowly and avoid the fishing marker buoys. Try not to disturb them or drive right through.
- You must deposit 100 Eur for any likely damage.

### **FISH TROPHY TAXIDERMY**

You have a unique opportunity to immortalize your trophy catch, not only by photographs, but also by taxidermy, thus preserving it permanently.

Taxidermy is performed by accomplished taxidermists who use a museum method of preservation. All you have to do is to catch a trophy. Size limits for fish taxidermy and pricelist are shown below:

Our fish mounts are guaranteed for 30 years, but if you keep them in glass showcases they are permanently guaranteed.

In addition, if you want to decorate the walls of your fishing or business or any other premises with your fish mount, we can mount it on an irregularly shaped log panel or driftwood from the river Drina. (See the picture.)



Dear anglers, we appologize in advance for the amount of purchase price of the trophies for taxidermy. But in the other hand all incomes of trophy purchase will be used exclusively for fish stocking of the Zvornik Lake, maintenance of the banks, collecting floating waste, and similar activities. All payments will be made to the account of a non-government organization **Eko-klub sportskih ribolovaca „Trofej“ (Anglers' ecoclub “Trophy”) from Mali Zvornik**. You will be duly informed on our webiste about all activities referring to fish stocking and cleaning of the lake and its banks.

Other services:

- Wall pedestal – depending on the size of the fish mount .....20 to 80 €
- Brass nameplates (with the name of fish, its length and weight, full name of the angler, place and date of catch) (See the picture.).....18 €
- Transport packages - specially made wooden crates for shipping fish mounts, decorated in ethno style..... 40 to 280 €
- Shipment expenses are to cargo of the purchaser
